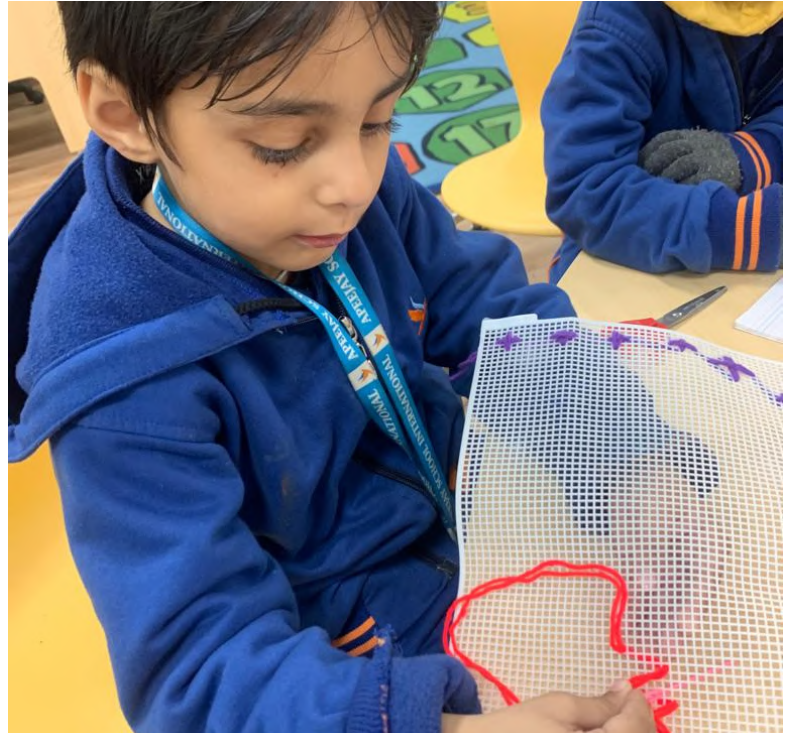


How We Express Ourselves

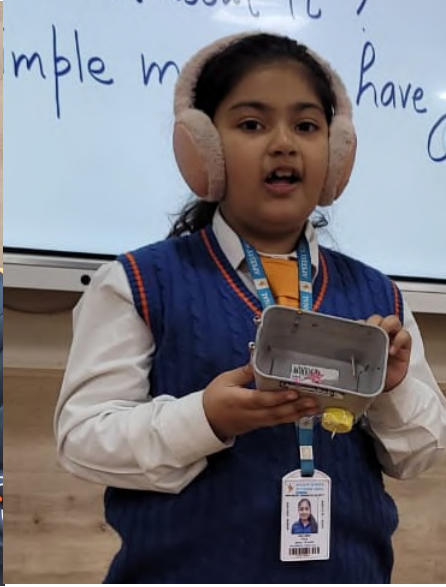
How We Organise Ourselves

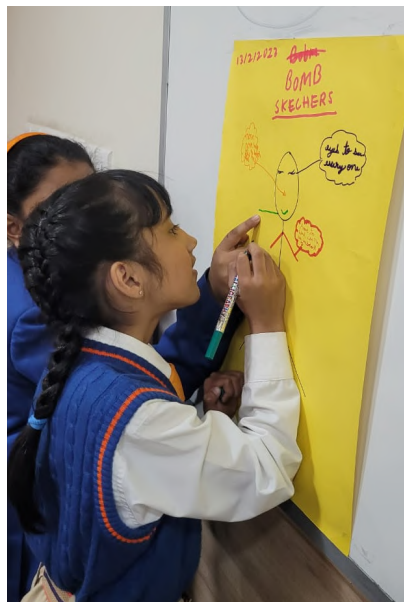
PYP3 – UOI EXPLORATION

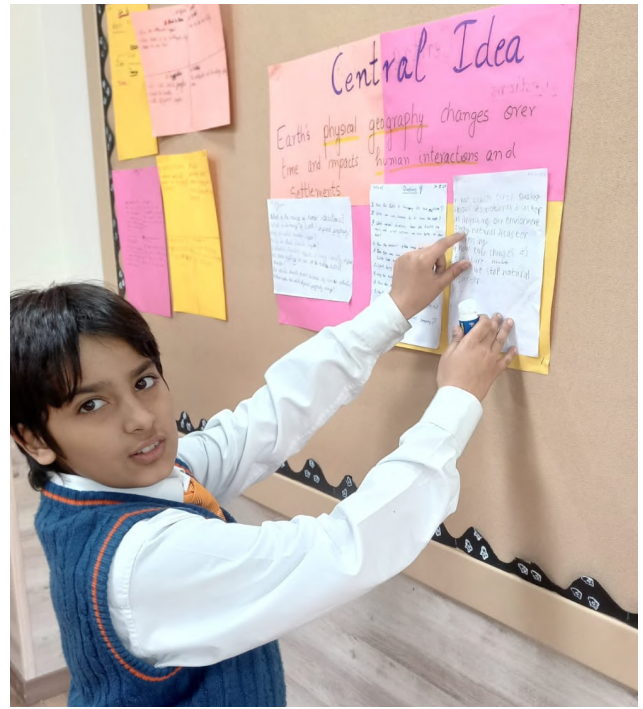
How The World Works

PYP 4 students culminated their learning of the unit on Energy by making and presenting a working model of a solar oven. They tuned-in to a new unit on Economic Activities with a provocation activity of thinking and designing a business for themselves. They are interviewing people to understand more about the topic.

During this month, we concluded our unit with an engaging task where learners showcased their understanding of creativity and different perspectives on problems, where they designed a product or app idea that can be launched. They also explained how it is helpful to the world. We also began with our new unit of inquiry, where we unpacked the central idea and tuned in to the earth's physical geography, followed by finding out how the earth's physical features have changed and are changing over time.



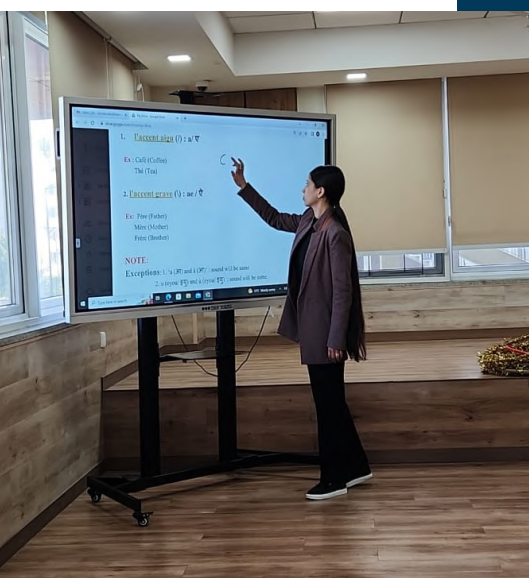
MYP-Special Assembly on French Phonetics



LEARNING FRENCH PHONETICS

A workshop on 'Learning Phonetics' was conducted for MYP and PYP French students.

The French language always fascinates people for manifold reasons. To gain proficiency in the language, one should learn phonetics to improve their listening and speaking skills. It's important to understand the sounds and accents to build a strong grip over language.



MYP-Special Assembly-Practicing Self Reflection



A session on Practicing Self-Reflection was conducted with the students of MYP, where students shared their thoughts on the significance of reflection, how frequently they engage in the process, and how helpful they find it. On being asked what kind of questions/prompts they would put in a self-reflection journal, students came up with interesting responses like "What could have been done differently?" or "What did I learn from this experience?" etc.

As part of understanding the power of self-reflection, a video on "Why Introspection Matters" was played, which referred to a traditional folktale called 'Androcles and the Lion' followed by students being given two journal prompts to help them reflect on the learnings of the past year.



DP-Workshop on Academic Integrity



Honesty, trust, fairness, respect, responsibility, and courage are some of the fundamental values that inform the idea of Academic Integrity. Technological advancement, despite its many advantages, comes with the risk of plagiarism and inauthenticity, making it difficult for students, sometimes, to commit to these values. To help students understand the importance of these values, a workshop on 'Academic Integrity in the Digital Age' was organised for Diploma Programme (DP)- I students and their parents.

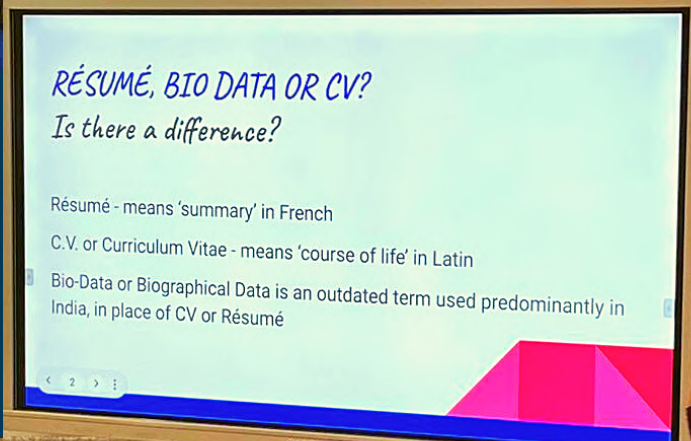


DP-Workshop on CV and SOP Building

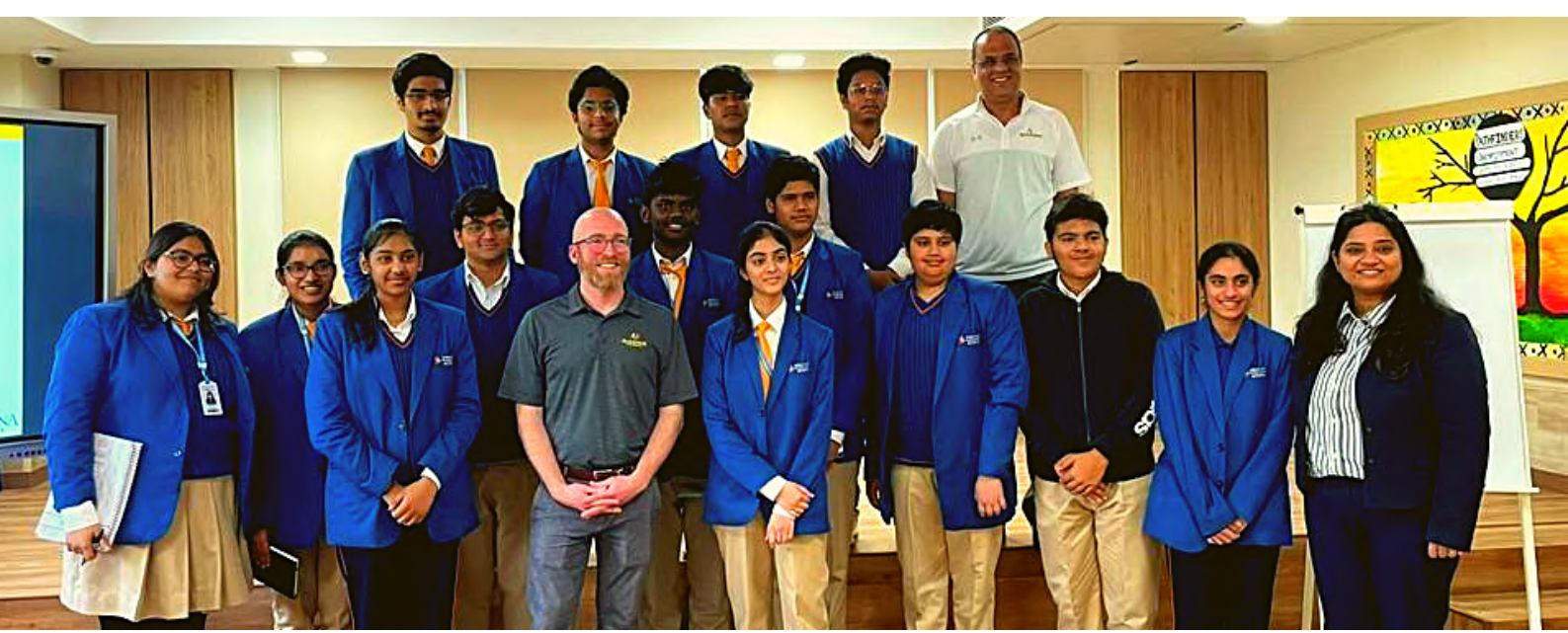


“You only get one chance to make a first impression.”

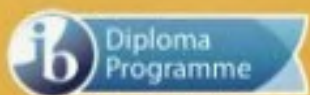

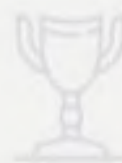
